EVENT OVERVIEW

Background

Islamic social finance has an important role in the development of Islamic economics in Indonesia. Zakat, *Infaq*, and *Sadaqah* have contributed to the economic development, especially during the Covid 19 Pandemic. Zakat has proven as a tool to alleviate poverty and social empowerment for *mustahiq* (the need). The Covid 19 Pandemic has changed financial management, including Islamic social finance. Society must quickly adapt to the new management system and digitalization, to meet the safety and keep effective for *mauquf alaih* (beneficiaries). 


